A mangle board (*mangletre*) was a common engagement gift from a young man to a young lady. The mangle was used to iron cloth. Cloth was wrapped around a rod, and then rolled across a table with the mangle, removing the wrinkles. This horse forms the handle of the mangle, and the board is decorated with chip carving.
