FFY 2009 HPF Appropriations

The Senate passed the FY09 Omnibus Appropriations Bill which awards an additional \$3.1 million for SHPOs! The bill provides a total of \$69.5 million from the Historic Preservation Fund and includes increases for SHPOs and THPOs. Below is a breakout of the FY09 funding (in millions) compared to FY08 levels:

SHPOs	\$42.5	\$39.376	+3.124
THPOs	\$7.0	\$6.3	+.7
Save America's Treasures	\$20.0	\$24.61	-\$4.61
Preserve America Grants	\$0	\$7.3	-\$7.3

The ND SHPO portion of the HPF is \$627,133. We are currently in the process of completing the federal application and then on to finalizing the CLG contracts.

Grant Opportunities

Save America's Treasures

Applications for National Park Service Save America's Treasures grants are now available. The program is one of the largest and most successful grant programs for the protection of our nation's irreplaceable and endangered cultural heritage. Grants are available for preservation and/or conservation work on nationally significant intellectual and cultural artifacts and historic structures and sites. Eligible applicants include federal, state, local, and tribal government entities, and nonprofit organizations. The competitive matching-grant program is administered by the National Park Service in partnership with the National Endowment for the Arts, the National Endowment for the Humanities, the Institute of Museum and Library Services and the President's Committee on the Arts and the Humanities. NEH Preservation Assistance Grants

Preservation Assistance Grants for Smaller Institutions help small and mid-sized institutions, such as libraries, museums, historical societies, archival repositories, town and county records offices, and colleges, improve their ability to preserve and care for their humanities collections. Awards of up to \$6,000 support preservation related collection assessments, consultations, training and workshops, and institutional and collaborative disaster and emergency planning. Grants cover consultant fees, workshop registration fees, related travel and per diem expenses, and the costs of purchasing and shipping preservation supplies and equipment.
