

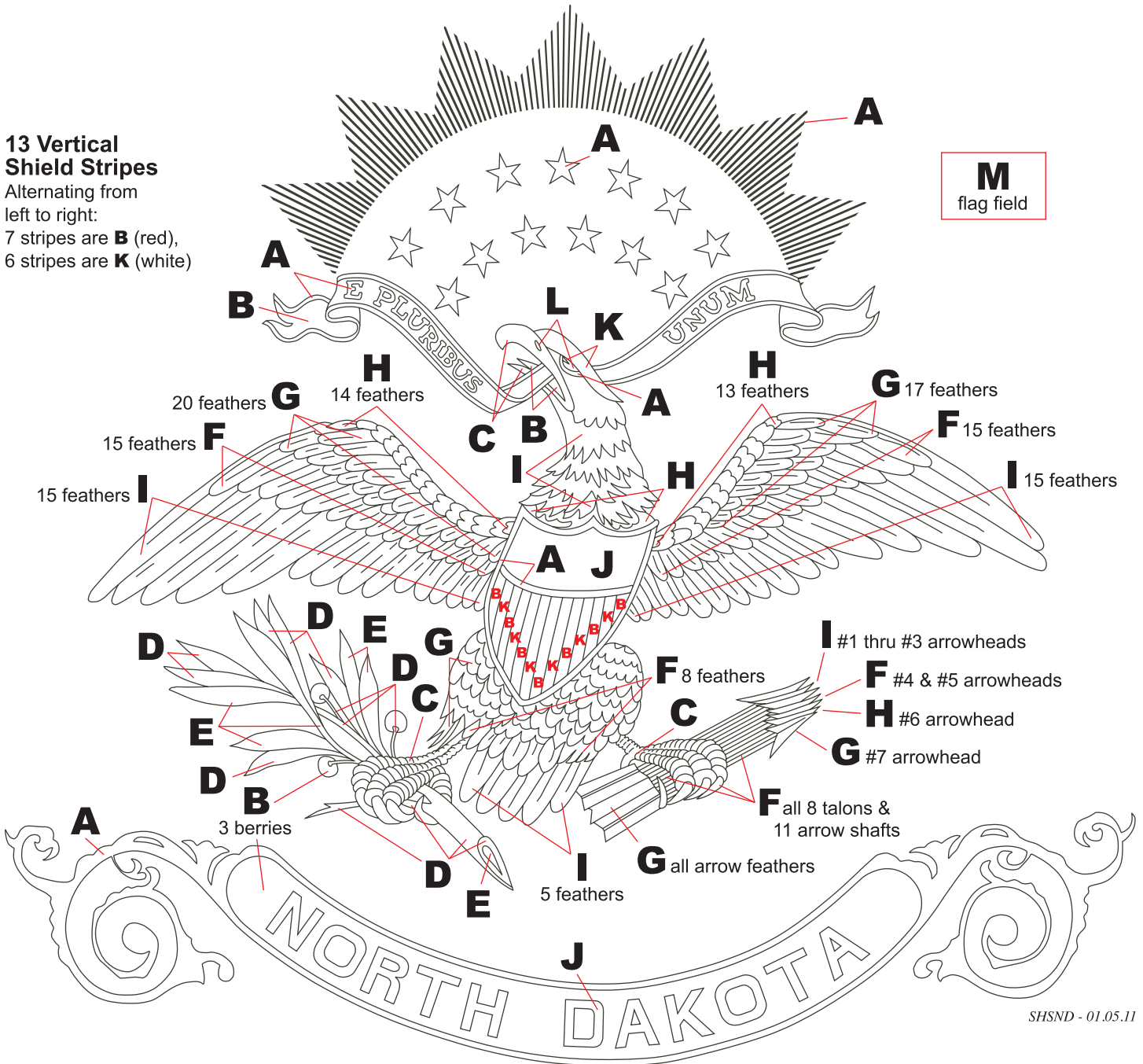
North Dakota State Flag Color Recommendations

In cooperation with the Secretary of State, this guide provides accurate colors for the North Dakota state flag. The Pantone international color matching system is built around eight basic colors plus black and white. Printers who keep the basic colors in stock can mix ink to match the 1,300+ colors shown in guides and swatch books published by Pantone, Inc. 13 Vertical Shield Stripes

Alternating from left to right:

7 stripes are **B** (red),
6 stripes are **K** (white)
